

## Early Years funding

There are currently 4 funding streams:

### 570 hours of 'disadvantaged' 2YO funding

Eligibility criteria: Economic i.e. household income less than £15,400 (applications via [www.familyspacecroydon.co.uk](http://www.familyspacecroydon.co.uk)) or Looked After Child or Child with an Education Health Care Plan/SEND

### 570 hours of 'expanded' 2YO funding (working families)

Eligibility criteria: Both parents must be working a minimum of 16 hours per week, earning between the minimum wage and 100k per year. (applications via HMRC website [www.childcarechoices.gov.uk](http://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk))

### 570 hours of universal 3YO funding

No criteria: All children are entitled to 15 universal hours from the term after they turn 3

### Extended entitlement i.e. an additional 570 hours of 3YO funding

Eligibility criteria: All parents in the family home need to be working the equivalent of 16 hours a week at minimum wage; all applications are made online via Childcare Choices [www.childcarechoices.gov.uk](http://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk)

The 'disadvantaged' 2YO and universal 3&4YO funding are guaranteed whereas parents need to re-confirm their information with HMRC every 3 months to ensure the extended and 2YO expanded hours remain valid. Therefore, this needs to be considered when structuring your funded offer.

Funding can be delivered as either a term time offer i.e. delivered as 15 hours over 38 weeks (570 hours) or a stretched offer where the hours are spread over more weeks e.g. 11 hours over 51 weeks (561 hours) or 12 hours over 47 weeks (564 hours) etc. Any funded offer should clearly define what hours are funded and the costs of any additional services. Funding can be shared between any 2 sites in one day. Please see the examples below:

#### Term time offers:

Pre-school 1 is open every day from 8.45 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. for 38 weeks of the year and offers 3-hour packages of education and care as shown, children bring a packed lunch:

Pre-school 2 is open every day from 9.00 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. for 38 weeks of the year and offers 3-hour packages of education and care as shown, children bring a packed lunch:

Any day nursery offering a term time offer has more flexibility in their offer as their opening hours are longer and therefore they could offer solid 6 hour funded offers as shown:

Lunch is served from 12 o'clock and there is a daily food charge of £5.

#### Stretched offers:

Any day nursery who is open for 47 weeks a year can offer 24 funded hours a week and therefore use the 6-hour models described above as  $47 \times 24 = 1,128$  hours.

Day nurseries who are open all the year round i.e. 51 weeks effectively offer 22 funded hours a week so parents could choose **four** 5.5-hour session meaning that anyone attending full time would pay full day rates for one day a week.

Lunch is served from 12 o'clock and there is a daily food charge of £5.00.

Some childminders do not work every day; therefore, the offer could be as shown below, children who are accessing 2YO or 3&4YO universal funding attend 3 sessions subject to one per day and a child who is eligible for the extended entitlement attends all 6. Food is

charged at £3.00 per session or £5.00 per day or a parent can provide their own meals and snacks.
